Ines "Inez" (Lenotti) Laird, 74, of Suffield, passed away suddenly on Tuesday (March 15, 2011) at the UConn Medical Center with her loving daughter Gina at her side. Born on July 31, 1936 in Crero, Torri Del Benaco, Italy, she was the daughter of the late Antonio and Giuseppina (Consolini) Lenotti. Inez came to America in 1947, first living in Hartford, then West Hartford where she resided for many years, before moving to Suffield. She worked with the State Connecticut Office of Policy and Management and the Connecticut State University System, retiring in 1992. Inez was a member of Price Thomas of Savoy Society Women's Auxiliary in Avon, and the Social Action/ Human Needs Ministry of Sacred Heart Church in Suffield. She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Gina and Mark Dion and their two sons, Christian and Joseph, all of Suffield. They will miss their mother and "Nonna" dearly. Inez also leaves many relatives in Italy.
